

IGFR HISTORY

In 1963 Gavin Reekie, as Governor Nominee for district 101, attended the World Assembly at Lake Placid in New York State and at the final banquet was seated along with his wife Connie, at the table of the incoming World President Carl Miller. Carl's theme for the year ahead was "Meeting Rotary's Challenge in the Space Age" and promoted the idea of Matched Districts.

Gavin related the wonderful golfing liaison between District 101 and District 728 and the Jackson Christy Porridge Bowl Trophy and suggested, to further the World theme of "Matched Districts" that Carl should develop this golfing fellowship on a WORLD basis. Carl responded "Gavin, I want you good people in Scotland to organize a similar competition between Districts on a World basis and I will provide you with a suitable trophy. I will be in Scotland in two months time. Let me have your ideas and we will finalize the details then." This meeting took place at Gleneagles hotel, Scotland, on the 17th August 1963.

Carl was then the World President of Rotary International and Gavin was District Governor of District 101. Also present at the meeting were William Carter, President of R.I.B.I. and Willie McAslam, Governor of District 102, the only other District in Scotland at that time. Based on Carl Miller's theme "Meeting Rotary's Challenge in the Space Age" and after much discussion, the well known Jewellers, A & C. Cairns-Cross, Perth, Scotland, produced a suitable design.

The Carl Miller Trophy continues to be the centerpiece of the many trophies and awards which have grown through the years. The Trophy cost 256 English pounds in 1964, which was paid by President Carl and continues today as the most coveted of the IGFR trophies both for its intrinsic value as well as its meaning to fellow golfing Rotarians.

Gavin Reekie presented the Runner-up trophy and it continues today. Both are emblematic of the Space Age theme of President Carl.

The rules and the number of participants have changed considerably since the first World Tournament was held at St. Andrews, Scotland. There were 47 entrants and 10 countries represented. In 1998 there were over 500 Rotarians and guests, with more than 400 golfers in Pinehurst, North-Carolina, USA, coming from 28 countries.

At the 1997 meeting of the Board of Directors, a decision was made to incorporate the Stableford system to determine winners of many different groups and the 1998 Pinehurst venue was the first occasion to use this scoring system.

Nowadays the Championships are played between Rotarian golfers (men and ladies) and three handicap divisions were introduced.

From all the founder members of IGFR, only Gaston Barras is still with us today, and very actif in Rotary golf. He was the founder President of IGFR Europe in 1975. There are now over 20 national golfing fellowship groups.

43 YEARS IGER EUROPE HISTORY (1975 - 2017)

A shorter story, but already 43 European Rotary Golf Championships organized!

At the 1974 World Championship in St. Andrews, Gaston F. Barras (Switzerland) met his two friends Armand delvaux (Luxemburg) and Francesco Folonari (Italy), and at his suggestion they decided to create the European Rotary Golf Championships; The first of these took place at Crans-sur-Sierre (Switzerland) in 1975.



ENJOY YOUR GOLF

The Damme Golf and Country Club and the Royal Ostend Golfclub will welcome you on their beautiful courses.

All Rotarian-golfers and partner-golfers will play both courses.

Some 1 time Ostend and 2 times Damme, the others 1 time Damme and 2 times Ostend.

On Tuesday 50% of the players will play a 4-ball BB competition at Royal Ostend. The other half at Damme.
This means two winners! And 2 runners-up!

The European championship itself will take place for all players on both courses.

The aggregate score of your performance at Damme on Thursday and at Ostend on Friday (or vice versa) will give the final result.

TRANSPORT TO AND FROM THE GOLFCOURSES

If you wish the OC can take care of your golfbag and bring it to the golfclub where you are planned to play that day. A tag with your identification number will then be fixed on your golfbag.



Take 3 clubs with you, the club you expect to use and the one on either side of it.

The first player listed in the tee-sheet in each flight will be designated as the **flight captain** responsible for monitoring the pace of play.

To ensure an enjoyable event for everyone, please do your best to keep your flight moving.

Please remember that one slow flight can disrupt the entire day's play for everyone behind you.

And do not forget you are your own referee!

This means that you always play fair and correct as the Rules of the Royal & Ancient describe.

Before, during and after the game of golf the Rotarian Four-Way Test is in charge.

Is it the TRUTH?

Is it FAIR to all concerned?

Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?


